- ❖ To ensure easy access to collections through the use of emerging integrated technology so that all collections can be readily accessible

- ❖ To establish a strong linkage with Government agencies such as INFLIBNET, National Digital Library, E-content Platforms, and Open learning Portals in the country and abroad.
- ❖ To support for Conservation of Knowledge created by the ACU and Its Constituent colleges for present and future uses of the Learning community
- ❖ To promote information literacy as an activity of the Library in enhancing the skills of the stakeholders.

LIBRARY COLLECTION:

BGSCE Library established in the year **2007** with the collection of **2085** books, now it has reached more than **7886 books** and other resources pertinent to the B.Ed. Programme and Education disciplines to support curriculum needs of the students, Research scholars and faculty members. Library collection includes books, periodicals (Journals, Magazines, and Newspapers), and other resource materials in a variety of formats. The College Library, easily accessible to all the departments in the college has steadily grown over the years and it has **7886 books and 12 National and International Journals**. It includes text books, reference books, and general books.

WORKING HOURS:

The library is kept open for readers from 09.00 AM to 5.00 PM on all working days with the transactions at the circulation counter except Sundays and holidays.

SERVICES:

Our library services include –

➤ **Circulation of Books**

The Students/users are eligible to borrow **up to 4 Books i.e. 2 from book bank** (*Students, who belong to OBC and General Categories, can borrow two books and four for SC, ST and C-I*) **against identity card for a period of 7 days. Faculty members can borrow up to 6 books.** The books kept in reference section and the periodicals normally will not be issued. However under certain conditions the reference textbooks are issued to the faculty and Research Scholars for overnight reference and return. Those who fail to return/renew the books within a specified due date will be levied an overdue charge of Rs. one per book per day.

➤ **Open Access System**

The greatest advantage that a Library can offer to its readers is its open access or open shelf system. This system enables the users to have direct and easy access to the book collection providing good opportunity and freedom to examine and browse the books. It encourages the users to develop a closer acquaintance with the diversity of information sources available in the Library. Keeping this in mind, the Library is practicing Open Access System.

➤ **Books/Periodicals Display**

Newly acquired (New arrivals) Books, journals, magazines and Latest Issues will be displayed as and when received.

➤ **Inter-Library loan**

The books of our library will be sent to various our institute libraries on Inter Library Loan as per the request from our institute Libraries. The library also used to get some books Inter Library Loan basis from other our institute libraries as request by our users. The DELNET's (<https://delnet.in/>) (<http://164.100.247.26/>) database on Internet is used for the location of the university library where the book in demand is available.

➤ **Reprography service/ Photostat copy:**

The Library provides reprographic service to the users on priced basis within the Library primessis. This saves the time of the users to a great extent.

➤ **Online Public Access Catalogue (Web-OPAC)**

It is one of the most widely used databases of the library and is accessible 24×7 via library web page. Besides listing all the documents available in the library, it allows on-line renewal and reservation, circulation, fine collection, and indicates status of a particular book. The OPAC is searchable & allows users searching by any combination of author, title, subject/keywords, accession number, subject and several other fields of

methods. Online Public Access Catalogue (OPAC) facility has been provided for the benefit of the users to access databases of books, theses, dissertations and serials of our university collection. Proper training is also provided to the students, about the use of OPAC system (<http://103.42.87.12:8004/>) in the beginning of the academic year.

➤ **Institutional Repository**

DSpace is an open source repository software package typically used for creating open access repositories for scholarly and/or published digital content.

➤ **Library Automation:**

Now-a-days Library Automations are considered as a powerful tool for any type of library to make its services very easy and relatively reliable to access the resources. The Library Automation of different kinds with powerful features are available in the market; which can also be used in academic library in order to promote library activities and services for the benefit of academic fraternity and research output. We done Automations successfully with help of **Koha software** in BGS College of Education.

➤ **Question bank:**

Previous years B.Ed Question papers are arranged subject wise in multiple copies and will be provided to users to take photocopies on request. The soft copy and Hard copy of question papers are available in the Library.

➤ **Plagiarism Check:**

Users are requested to note the following guidelines frame to avail plagiarism check services the library is using “URKUND” plagiarism checker software to get the percentage of similar contents already published in various online information sources.

➤ **Digital Library:**

The Institution has set up Tech Focus Digital Library with 43 computers having adequate internet connectivity for navigating. The objective of this facility is to support self-learning activities. Library has adopted open access system for stockholders to browse freely the books, e-books/e-journals through **Wi-Fi facility** across the library and campus.



















Open Access Resources
